

Esthetic Risk Assessment for Dental Implant Therapy

| Esthetic Risk Factors | Low | Medium | High |

| Medical status | Healthy | | Compromised |
| Smoking habit | Non-smoker | <10 cig/day | >10 cig/day |
| Patient's esthetic expectation | Low | Medium | High |
| Lip line | Low | Medium | High |
| Gingival biotype | Thick | Medium | Thin |
| Shape of tooth crowns | Rectangular | | Triangular |
| Infection at implant site | None | | Present |
| Bone level at adjacent teeth | ≤ 5 mm to CP | 5.5-6.5 mm to CP | ≥ 7 mm to CP |
| Restorative status of neighboring teeth | Virgin | | Restored |
| Width of edentulous span | 1 tooth ideal | 1 tooth tight | 2 teeth or more |
| Soft-tissue anatomy | Intact soft tissue | | Soft tissue defect |
| Bone anatomy of alveolar crest | Defect absent | Horizontal defect | Vertical defect |
